F 0684 Level of Harm - Minimal harm or potential for actual harm Residents Affected - Few	Provide appropriate treatment and care according to orders, resident's preferences and goals. **NOTE- TERMS IN BRACKETS HAVE BEEN EDITED TO PROTECT CONFIDENTIALITY** Based on interview and record review, the facility failed to ensure that medications were administered according to physician ordered parameters for two of three residents reviewed (Resident 2 and 8) when:1.For Resident 2, the licensed nurse administered the medication Losartan (high blood pressure medication) 25 mg (mg - unit of measurement) outside of the physician ordered parameters of hold for SBP (systolic [top number of blood pressure] blood pressure) less than 140 mmhg (mmhg - unit of measurement); and2.For Resident 8, the licensed nurse administered the medication Carvedilol (high blood pressure medication) 3.125 mg outside of the physician ordered parameters of hold for SBP less than 110 mmhg.This failure had the potential for Resident 2 and 8 to experience undesired hypotension.Findings:1.On June 24, 2026, Resident 2's medical record was reviewed.The admission record indicated Resident 2 was admitted to the facility on [DATE], with diagnoses which included dementia (loss of memory), and hypertension (high blood pressure).The history and physical dated May 19, 2026, indicated Resident 2 had the capacity to make decisions.The Medication Administration Record (MAR) for the month of June 2026, indicated the following: .Losartan Potassium Oral Tablet.Give 25 mg by mouth in the morning related to Hypertension.Hold for SBP less than 140.9:00 am.June 19.BP (blood pressure) 110/80.There was documented evidence that Resident 2 received the 9:00 am dose of the medication Losartan 25 mg with a SBP of 110/80, which was within the physician ordered parameter of hold if SBP is less than 140.2.On June 24, 2026, Resident 8's medical record was reviewed.The admission record indicated Resident 8 was admitted to the facility on [DATE], with diagnoses which included dementia and hypertension.The history and physical dated 04/15/2026, indicated Resident 8 had the capacity to make decisions.The MAR for the month of June 2026, indicated the following: .Carvedilol Oral Tablet.Give 3.125 mg by mouth two times a day related to Hypertension.Hold for SBP.less than 110.7:00 am.June 22 BP (blood pressure) 102/57.There was documented evidence that Resident 8 received the 7:00 am dose of the medication Carvedilol 3.125 mg with a SBP of 102/57, which was within the physician ordered parameter of hold if SBP is less than 110.On June 24, 2026, at 2:33 pm, a concurrent interview and record review was conducted with the Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN) of Resident 2 and Resident 8. The LVN stated Resident 2's MAR indicated on June 19, 2026, Resident 2 was administered the 9:00 am dose of the medication Losartan 25 mg with a SBP of 110/80. The LVN stated the medication Losartan had a physician ordered parameter to hold for SBP less than 140. The LVN stated the medication Losartan should have been held due to the SBP being outside of physician ordered parameters.The LVN stated Resident 8's MAR indicated on June 22, 2026, Resident 8 was administered the 7:00 am dose of the medication Carvedilol 3.125 mg with a SBP of 102/57. The LVN stated the medication Carvedilol had a physician ordered parameter to hold for SBP less than 110. The LVN stated the medication Carvedilol should have been held due to the SBP being outside of physician ordered parameters.The LVN stated that the possible outcomes of administering hypertension medication outside of physician ordered parameters are low BP, low heart rate, dizziness, and lethargy.On June 24, 2026, at 2:52 pm, a concurrent interview and record review was conducted with the Director of Nursing (DON). The DON stated the facility expectations for nursing are to administer medication according to physicians orders. The (continued on next page)

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F 0684 Level of Harm - Minimal harm or potential for actual harm Residents Affected - Few	stated Resident 2's MAR indicated on June 19, 2026, Resident 2 was administered the 9:00 am dose of the medication Losartan 25 mg with a SBP of 110/80 and a physician ordered parameter to hold Losartan for SBP less than 140. The DON stated the medication Losartan should have been held due to the SBP being outside of physician ordered parameters. The DON stated Resident 8's MAR indicated on June 22, 2026, Resident 8 was administered the 7:00 am dose of the medication Carvedilol 3.125 mg with a SBP of 102/57 and a physician ordered parameter to hold Carvedilol for SBP less than 110. The DON stated the medication Carvedilol should have been held due to the SBP being outside of physician ordered parameters. The DON stated the possible outcome of administering hypertension medication outside of the physician parameters is undesired hypotension. A review of the facility policy and procedure titled, Administering Medications, dated 2001, indicated Medications are administered in a safe manner, and as prescribed. Medications are administered in accordance with prescriber orders. The following information is checked/verified for each resident prior to administering medications. vitals signs, if necessary.
